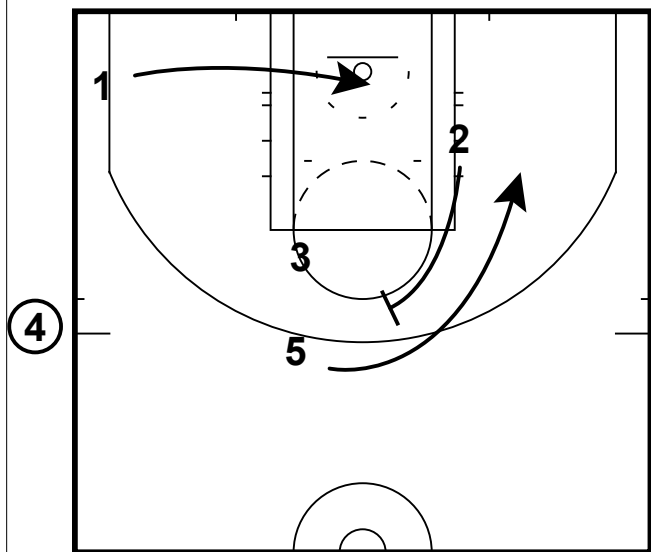
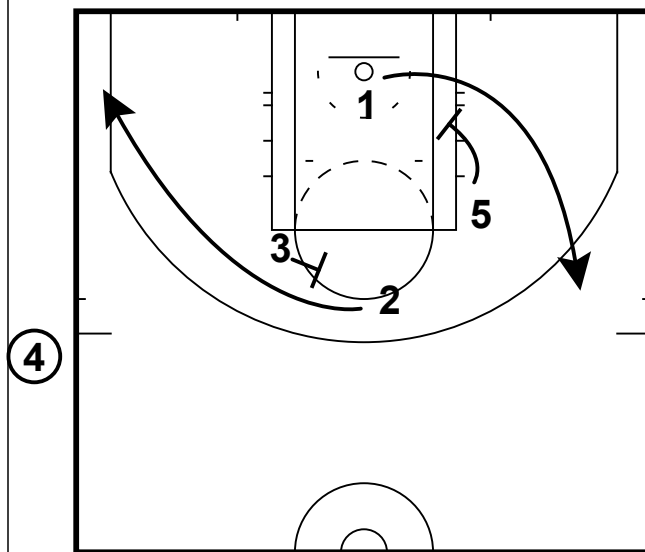


SOB: MIAMI HEAT (LEBRON)



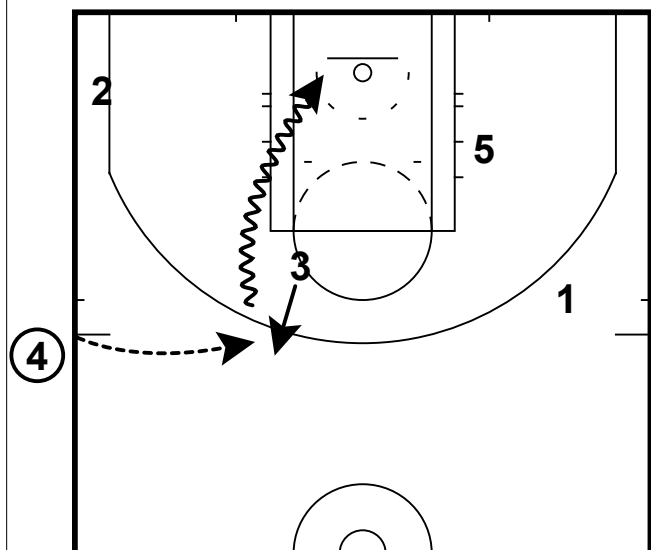
- 1) This is the play that the Heat ran at the end of OT in Game 1 of the Eastern Conference Finals 2013 to win .
- 2) Put your best shooter (Ray Allen) on the opposite block. And have him set a back screen for your post.
- 3) The point guard should move under the bucket.

SOB: MIAMI HEAT (LEBRON)



- 1) Now your shooter will run off of a brush screen from 3 (Lebron). It's hard to help off of the best player here, but with the best shooter coming off here - it will create a distraction.
- 2) On the weakside, 1 will come off of a down screen from 5. This will keep the defense occupied on the weakside.

SOB: MIAMI HEAT (LEBRON)



- 1) Now with all three players on the court who have rotated on the perimeter, 3 steps to the arc to receive the pass.
- 2) Now the defenders have all locked into the offensive players and opens up the lane for your best play maker.
- 3) In this game, Paul George gets caught totally off balance on the closeout and Lebron wins the game with a lay-up.
