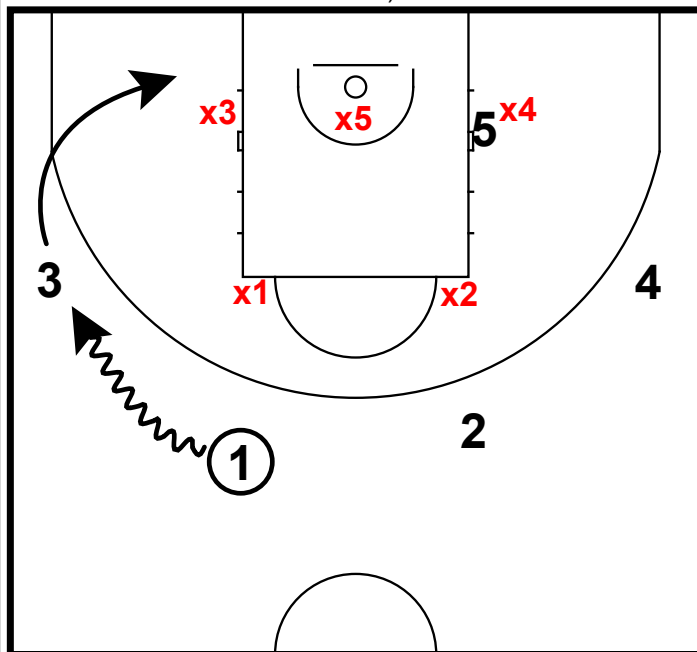
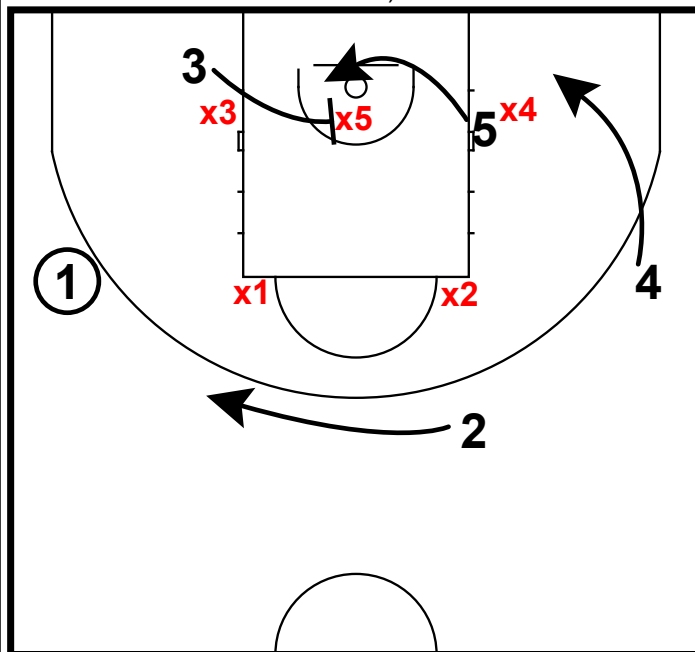


EURO LEAGUE: FINLAND ZONE (U18 NATIONAL TEAM)



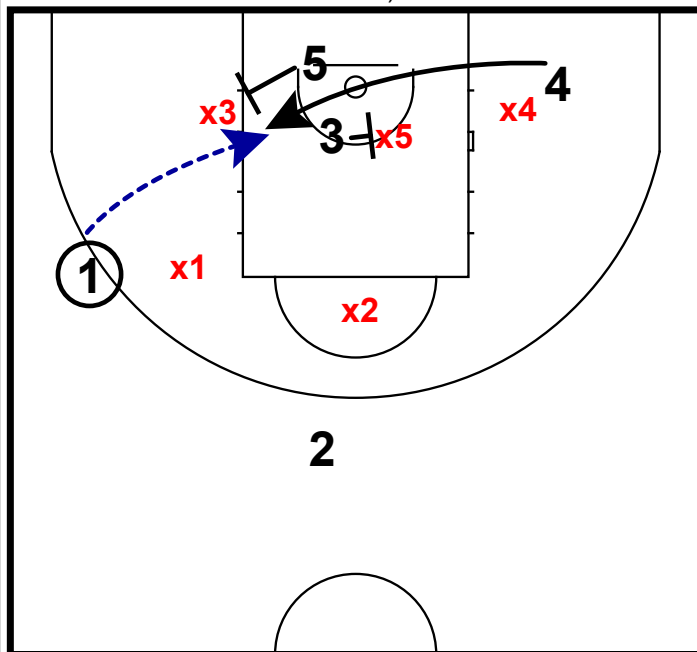
- 1) This set is a play that the Finnish U18 National team used last summer.
- 2) It starts in a 4 out look with both post players starting opposite of where the ball will be dribbled.

EURO LEAGUE: FINLAND ZONE (U18 NATIONAL TEAM)



- 1) After 3 is pushed to the corner, he will set a middle screen for 5 who is on the opposite block.
- 2) On the opposite wing, 4 is diving to the baseline to set up his next movement.
- 3) 2 will follow the dribble.

EURO LEAGUE: FINLAND ZONE (U18 NATIONAL TEAM)



- 1) 3 will stick with that screen for an extra second while 5 sets a backscreen on 3.
- 2) 4 will flash in the gap for an easy score.
- 3) **Coaching Point:** Timing is everything here. 3 can't stick in the lane too long otherwise a lane violation will occur. 3 & 5's screens must occur almost simultaneously.
