

1) This is a great entry into a 2 man game out of a horns set. This would especially be good for a versatile 4 player who makes good decisions and is a threat to score in a $1 / 1$ situation.
2) The action is started by 2 clearing the side and getting a double screen from 5 \& 3 on the weakside.
3) The pg will throw the ball to 4 (Trammel) who steps out to the arc to meet the pass.

4) Many times the defense will be ready for the handoff and will defend it will.
5) However, defending two consectutive actions is more difficult. Trammel will ball screen for the pg and then slip hard to the rim. She becomes an instant threat to score on the move.
6) On the weakside it is important the players move to get proper spacing and to be a threat for the skip pass.

7) The pg will need to set up this cut by faking a basket cut up the middle of the court.
8) Then the pg will run off of 4 getting a dribble handoff. This is a great look for a quick point guard to get down hill and attack the basket, because there is not helpside.

9) A final option here for Trammel is to get a ballscreen from the opposite post.
10) After you have ran this play a few times, the defense will make the adjustment. So this time, Trammel will fake the handoff and then receive a ballscreen.
11) She now becomes a threat to hit the jumper and she is skilled enough to make the pass to the 5 player who rolls to the bucket.
