



- 1) Reading the defense on a screen requires practice and patience.
- 2) In this section we look at what should happen if the defense decides to "chase" the screen.
- 3) 2 should take the same approach as he/she did in the straight cut section by changing "**Speed & Direction**." However, with x2 chasing this sets up a curl cut in the middle of the lane. A lay-up or easy jumper in the middle of the lane will be open.
- 1) In this frame, once again we see the importance of making the "2nd cut" by the screener (4).
- 2) The defense may decide to take away the curl by having the screener's defender help on the curl cut. 4 will make the 2nd cut to the FT line for the jumper.
- 3) Again we see that being a "screener" will often be the player who gets open for the shot.
