<p>1) Reading the defense on a screen requires practice and patience.</p> <p>2) In this section we look at what should happen if the defense decides to "chase" the screen.</p> <p>3) 2 should take the same approach as he/she did in the straight cut section by changing "<b>Speed &amp; Direction</b>." However, with <b>x2</b> chasing - this sets up a curl cut in the middle of the lane. A lay-up or easy jumper in the middle of the lane will be open.</p>	<p>1) In this frame, once again we see the importance of making the "<b>2nd cut</b>" by the screener (4).</p> <p>2) The defense may decide to take away the curl by having the screener's defender help on the curl cut. 4 will make the 2nd cut to the FT line for the jumper.</p> <p>3) Again we see that being a "<b>screener</b>" will often be the player who gets open for the shot.</p>
