



- 3) But here we see that x2 expected the action & "*blew*" up the screen for **Thompson** which caused him to curl the screen into the lane.

- 1) Here Curry made a 2nd cut to the wing to receive the pass back from Lee
- 2) If Curry's man had helped on the curl cut, Curry would have been open at the arc.
- 1) Now with **Curry** with the ball on the wing, the Warriors set an elevator screen for **Thompson** in the lane.
- ${\bf 2)}$ The two post players came together to make sure he was able to get it off at the top of the key.
