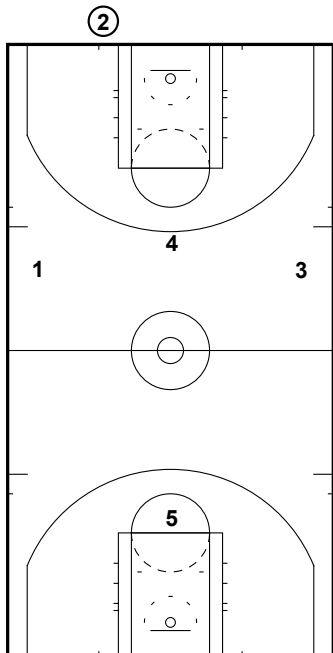
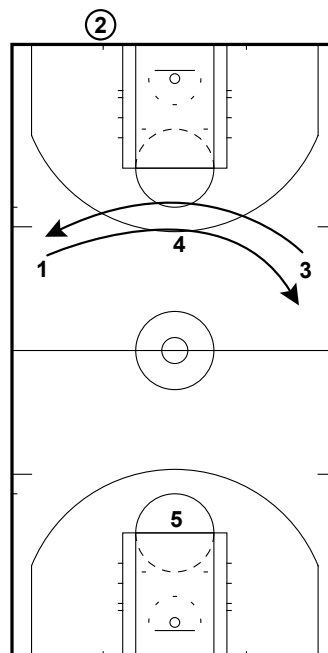


SHORT SECONDS: OKC THUNDER



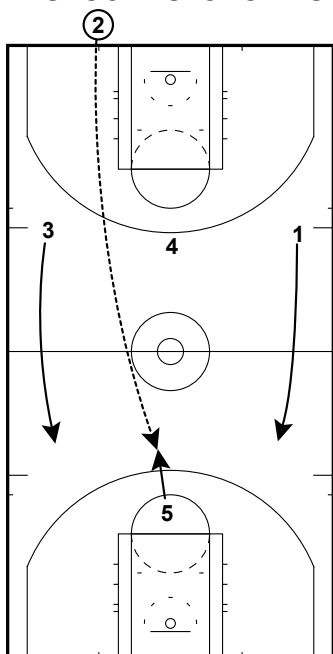

- 2) Although this play seemed to happen on accident, when studying the replays you can see that it was a purposeful play.

SHORT SECONDS: OKC THUNDER



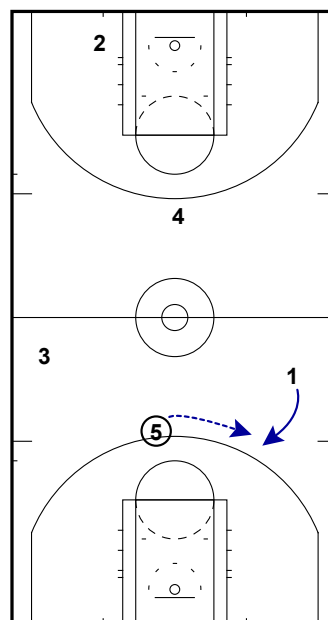
- 1) The opening action of this play occurred when the Fisher & Durrant criss-crossed in the front court.
- 2) This action was almost diversionary, because the Thunder had plans of throwing it to them with less than 3 seconds left on the clock.

SHORT SECONDS: OKC THUNDER



- 1) The ball was thrown the length of the court in an almost jump ball situation to Serge Ibaka.
- 2) This kind of reminds us of the Christian Laettner play that Duke ran years ago, however OKC had another plan. Notice that the two wings who had originally criss-crossed are now following the play.

SHORT SECONDS: OKC THUNDER



- 1) After catching the ball near the top of the key, Ibaka was able to tip the ball to Fisher who hit the shot at the buzzer.
- 2) Apparently the Heat defender had given up on the play which allowed Fisher a clean look at the buzzer.
