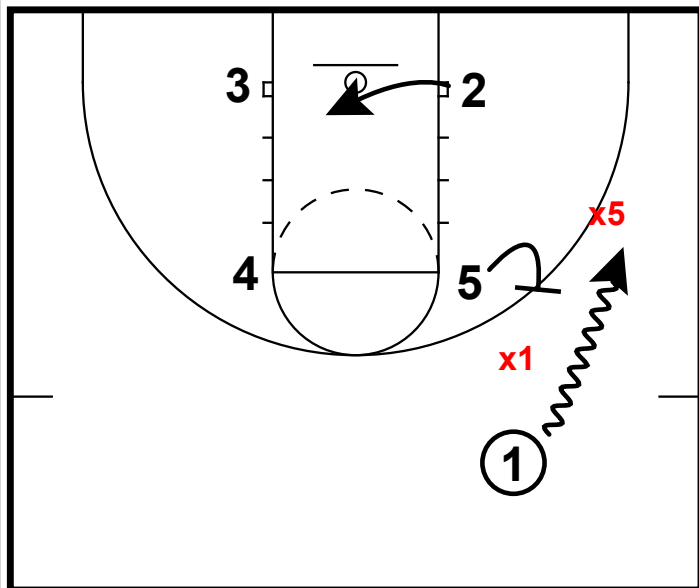
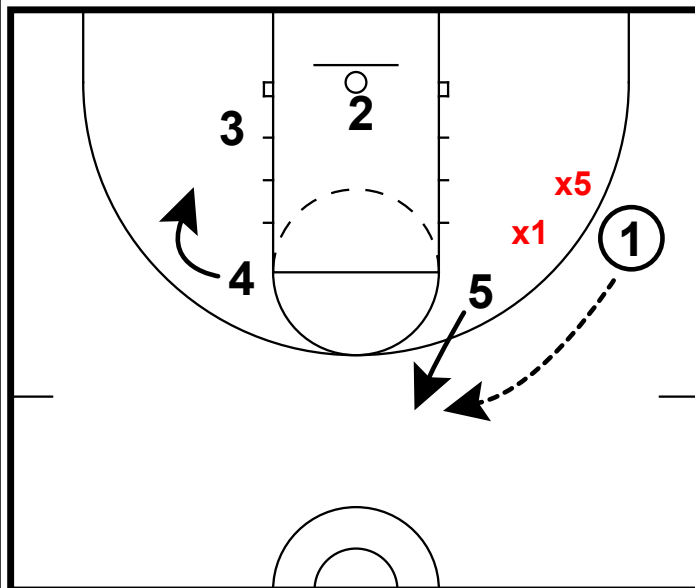


HALF-COURT: DEMATHA PICK-N-POP



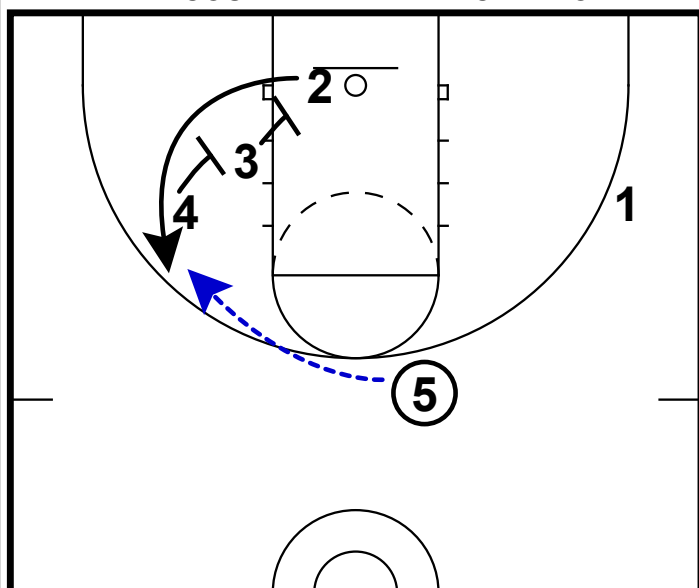
- 1) This was a base offense that **DeMatha** & coach **Mike Jones** used at the **Nike Extravaganza**.

HALF-COURT: DEMATHA PICK-N-POP



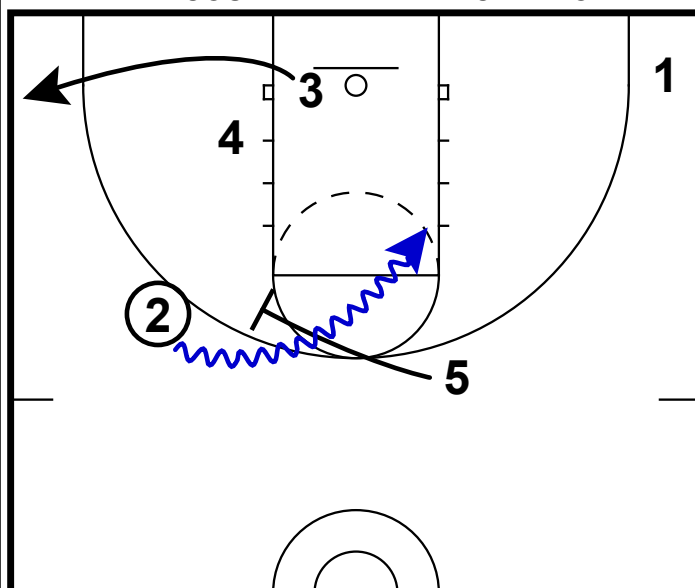
- 1) More times than not, the ball screen would draw a double team on the point guard.
- 2) This is a perfect time for a "pick-n-pop" opportunity. And because the DeMatha posts are versatile enough to face the basket & make a pass - this works.

- 1) One action that this could flow into is another ball skill here by the post player.
- 2) The PG fades to the corner & 3 will space to the corner, which opens the lane for either a pull-up jumper or drive and dish situation.
