

1) Out of a box set, start your guards \& posts diagonal from one another.
2) Start your best shooter in the ' 2 ' spot \& run him/her to the corner as the PG brings the ball to the right wing.

3) Now 3 will set a back screen for 4 and then pop to the top of the key as 5 moves to the opposite wing.
4) 4 could be open on the cut to the bucket, if not a pass to the top of the key is the look.

JEFF WALZ: BOX 1


1) After 2 runs past to the corner, 5 takes a step to the ball and rubs off of a screen to the top of the key.
2) 4 takes a step to the middle of the floor. This action is more of a distractor.

JEFF WALZ: BOX 1


1) The final action is one that rarely will occur if the rest of the actions are time properly - is a 2 man game look.
2) The post player will come set a ball screen \& roll to the bucket. The 4 player will flash up from the block as the guards exchange on the weakside.
