

LATE GAME SITUATION

When you need a 3, most defenses will switch all screens here.


You want your best shooter to be the ball handler. Bring your best ball handler off the double screen. Get a dribble handoff at the top of the key.

The opposite wing should run to the opposite corner looking to get a spot up 3.

However, the real shot you're looking for is the flare for 1 at the top of the key. The reason why this could work is with the multiple screens & switches it should cause confusion.

Your ball handler has two options for 3pt shooters or for slips by posts going to the rim.

HALF COURT: HAND-OFF FLARE



The most dangerous part of this action could come with dribble penetration. Too often teams shell up around the arc looking for the 3 instead of piercing the lane, which could open up a penetrate and kick opportunity.

This would be particularly good if you have a pick and pop 4 player.
